**1. NASA Satellite Data Server project status**

Ken announced that he will move to NOAA, but he will continue with his support of CEOS WGISS. Yonsook explained that there has been a design change of the NASA Satellite Data Server to use the NetCDF format response of the WCS under the version 1.1 specification. The NASA Satellite Data Server will support WCS that return NetCDF or HDF-EOS formatted data. RESTEC wanted to know if the NASA Satellite Data Server will work with the UM WCS software. Yonsook explained that RESTEC should send samples of requests to Dan Holloway and he will evaluate them for compatibility.

**2. JAXA WTF-CEOP Prototype System status**

Satoko explained that JAXA/RESTEC is developing a scenario for a flood, to be added to the WTF-CEOP JAXA Prototype system. Considering the next WGISS venue, the target is for floods in Vietnam.

Ben added two details to the status:

1. There are currently 109 registered users.
2. New samples of CEOP MOLTS data, in NetCDF CF compliant format, were received from MPI during December and we are examining how to put them online.

### **3. GEO Issues**

Ken explained that the 2007-2009 GEO Workplan Tasksheet was approved but needs some revision. WGISS work has been identified but it is on hold until “the next step” for the Tasksheet.

There was some discussion of the WA-06-05, WA-07-01, WA-07-02 and DA-07-06 GEO Task Sheets. However, the basic conclusion was that no further activity was appropriate until the GEO Workplan Tasksheet is revised or refined in the near future.

### **4. Next Face to Face meeting in March**

After some discussion March 15 (Thursday) was chosen for the JAXA/NASA meeting. Satoko asked RESTEC to prepare a list of items for the meeting, then Yonsook will prepare the agenda based on the list from RESTEC. This will probably be a one day meeting.

### **5. Any other business?**

Satoko explained that during Monday thru Wednesday of the CEOP meetings there will be various discussions, with a Data Management Working Group breakout session on Wednesday. There is a 15 minute time slot for a demo scheduled on Saturday morning. Satoko will share a detailed agenda when it becomes available. Ken said he might be available on Saturday morning to join the demo if necessary.

Satoko explained that Dr. Koike is scheduled to come to the CEOS WGISS meeting to give a presentation on the status and plans for CEOP.

Yonsook explained that by May it is hopeful that the NASA Satellite Data Server should be ready for a demo.
